Applications are invited from Non-Hindi speaking Indians, Foreigners and NRI's for admission to the following Hindi Correspondence Courses:-

1. Certificate Course in Hindi (Preliminary Course) through English/Tamil/ Malayalam/ Bangla /Odiya Medium).
2. Diploma Course in Hindi (Subsequent to Certificate Course) through English/Tamil/ Malayalam /Bangla Medium).
3. Advance Diploma Course in Hindi (Sr. Secondary Level) in Hindi Medium Only.

(A) ELIGIBILITY :-

1. Certificate Course in Hindi - is for the beginners who do not have any/very little knowledge of Hindi and is open to all Indians whose mother tongue is not Hindi and Foreigners/Indian Nationals/Settlers residing abroad irrespective of their mother tongue. The minimum age limit for admission as on 01/07/2025 is 10 years.
2. Diploma Course in Hindi - is for those who possess basic knowledge of Hindi and is open to all Indians whose mother tongue is not Hindi and Foreigners/Indians Nationals/Settlers residing abroad irrespective of their mother tongue. The minimum age limit for admission as on 01/07/2025 is 12 years.
3. Advance Diploma Course in Hindi - is for those who have sufficient knowledge of Hindi and is open to all Indians whose mother tongue is not Hindi and Foreigners/Indians Nationals/Settlers residing abroad irrespective of their mother tongue. The minimum age limit for admission as on 01/07/2025 is 14 years.
